Through a secure username and password parents will also have access to their child's team page, where they will be able to communicate with the coach via email; view the team roster and communicate with other parents; view updates to game and practice schedules; check out team news alerts and standings; share pre-approved video and pictures with the team; and upload unlimited videos and pictures and archive them by year, season and team to easily organize and share memories among fans.
